The projects proposed for this grant are listed here, followed by related photos.

At the GVG Branch Trailhead on Rt. 408:

- A GVGSP kiosk with four display windows for both Greenway and Nunda Village/Town historic and current information
- ^[] seating that includes benches attached to the kiosk and one (1) additional bench
- Image: A 12 ft Bicycle Rack (Nunda Kiwanis Club donation)
- An interpretive sign with history of the Genesee Valley Canal and Pennsylvania Railroad in the Town & Village of Nunda.
- One (1) wayfinding signpost with <u>3 signs pointing south</u> (Food, ATM, Murals or Shops) and <u>1 sign pointing west</u> to Lock #2 (Historic Site)

Enhancements needed to provide safe access for visitors to the Trailhead

- Signpost with sign directing visitors to Greenway Trailhead parking available on west side of Rt.408 (Will work with businesses and NYS DOT on appropriate placement.)
- Crosswalks painted for pedestrians at village street crossings: Vermont and Fourth Streets (Will work with NYS DOT to obtain crosswalk for State Street (Rt.408)

Wayfinding Signage from the Greenway to the village:

- Main GVG at Pickett Line Road: One (1) signpost with <u>3 signs</u> pointing down Pickett Line Road toward the village (Nunda - 0.35 mi., Food, Historic Site)
- □ Main GVG at Hay Road: One (1) signpost with <u>2 signs</u> pointing east (Food, Shops)
- Main GVG at Rt.408: One (1) signpost with <u>1 sign pointing north</u> for Food and <u>3</u> pointing south for Food, ATM, and Historic Site
- Branch GVG at Pentagass Road: One (1) signpost with <u>1 sign</u> pointing south on Branch GVG (Nunda 1.5 mi)
- Branch GVG at Halstead Road: One (1) signpost with <u>3 signs pointing south</u> (Historic Site, Food, ATM) and <u>2 signs pointing west</u> (Food, Shops)

At the village square in front of the Nunda Village Building on South side of square

- A Nunda Trail Town Informational Sign similar to the Historic Interpretive Sign at the GVG Branch Trailhead. The sign will include a village map, locations of Genesee Valley Greenway main and branch trails, route to access main trail from the village, Historic Sites (Genesee Valley Canal Lock #42 in village and Oakland Locks), village murals, locations of nearby outdoor recreation opportunities, and related QR codes. *See expanded description that follows*.
- Bicycle Rack 4 ft wide to accommodate 4 bicycles

At the Village Parking Lot on State Street (between First and Second Streets)

A 12 ft Bicycle Rack (Nunda Kiwanis Club donation)



Proposed location of Greenway Branch Trailhead - East side of North State Street (Rt.408)



Mt. Morris State St, GVGSP Tailhead showing bench design, and GVGSP kiosk that will be slightly modified to include benches on each side for additional seating.







The sign will include a village map, locations of Genesee Valley Greenway main and branch trails, route to access main trail from the village, Historic Sites (Genesee Valley Canal Lock #42 in village and Oakland Locks), village murals, and locations of nearby outdoor recreation opportunities - DEC Sonyea Forest & Rattlesnake Wildlife Area. This sign will also include QR codes for websites such as the GVG State Park Interactive web map, ExploreGeneseeValley.com (with Nunda Trail Town Information), and the Village &Town of Nunda websites.
