



2026 Invasive Species Walk

Join the Livingston County Environmental Management Council for an annual invasive species awareness walk! This year's walk will be guided by Michael Palermo of the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation.

Who? Everyone is welcome to join! This is a 1.5 mile trail that is primarily flat, but does have areas with a slight incline/decline. The trail is mostly comprised of mowed grass.

Where? The walk will be held at the Conesus Inlet Wildlife Management Area at the Boardwalk Trail, south of Sliker Hill Road. Parking will be at the trail entrance on West Swamp Road (State Route 256) at the parking lot with the large information kiosk.
